December began with the signature course of Delhi orthopaedic association which is Basic trauma fixation course, held on 3<sup>rd</sup> December at Hans hotel, Delhi. The course includes saw bone workshop to teach the delegates 6 basic fixation devices in orthopaedic which is screw, plate, nail, TBW, external fixator and DHS. A total of 40 delegates participated in this course.





**On 10<sup>th</sup> December, a one day conference was organized in LHMC discussing the paediatric hip problems. This course again targeted the post graduate students to make their clinical skills in diagnosing and managing the paediatric hip problems better. Around 50 delegates attended the conference, with content full lectures from faculty of esteemed medical colleges in Delhi.**



Following these great educational sessions in November and December, DOA again brought its signature course targeting post graduate residents and senior residents. The course theme is “Surgical post graduate instructional cadaveric course” (SPICC). The course was a 2 day course held in VMMC on 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of December 2017. 40 delegates participated in this course with 5 cadavers. Lower and upper limb approaches were discussed and delegates were given opportunity to train themselves on cadaver. This course was a huge success with lots of teaching and hands on training for delegates.
