Amidst the ongoing J&J fellows training program, on 13th January, DOA organized an education activity including clinical examination PG course of 1 day for PG exam appearing candidates. Course went very successful as far as brushing up of the basic concepts of post graduate students was concerned. Course was held in VMMC and attended by 2nd year and 3rd Post Graduate students of All the Delhi medical colleges. Post graduate student presented clinical long and short cases in front of faculty, where PG's were scrutinized over the accuracy of their clinical acumen.



Inspiring and encouraging exam appearing post graduate 3rd year students regarding the importance and relevance of good clinical skills, DOA moved forward for 2nd Paper writing skill course under the guidance of JCOT editorial team. Paper writing skill course was mainly meant for 1st and 2nd year Post graduate students and senior residents who desire to learn the basic art of writing a paper. Paper writing skill course is also a trademark course of DOA which has been purposefully designed to inculcate a desire in residents to publish their own papers.

Course was conducted on 21st January in Apollo Hospital, Sarita vihar, which was attended by 40 delegates and there occurred a wonderful discussion between delegates and faculty, illuminating all the darkness of ignorance in the field of paper writing.



Following this mega educational event of DOA, Indian Spinal Injury Centre organized an ankle and shoulder arthroscopy course which not only consist of live surgeries and didactic lectures rather delegates were given an opportunity to master the skills of arthroscopy in “hands on cadaveric workshop.”

The event was attended by more than 130 delegates and 50 faculties from all

The last day of the event was held at the Apex Trauma Centre. The day started with few talks on shoulder and ankle approaches in supine position after which the action shifted to the cadaveric lab. The event was highly appreciated for its scientific content and overall organization.
